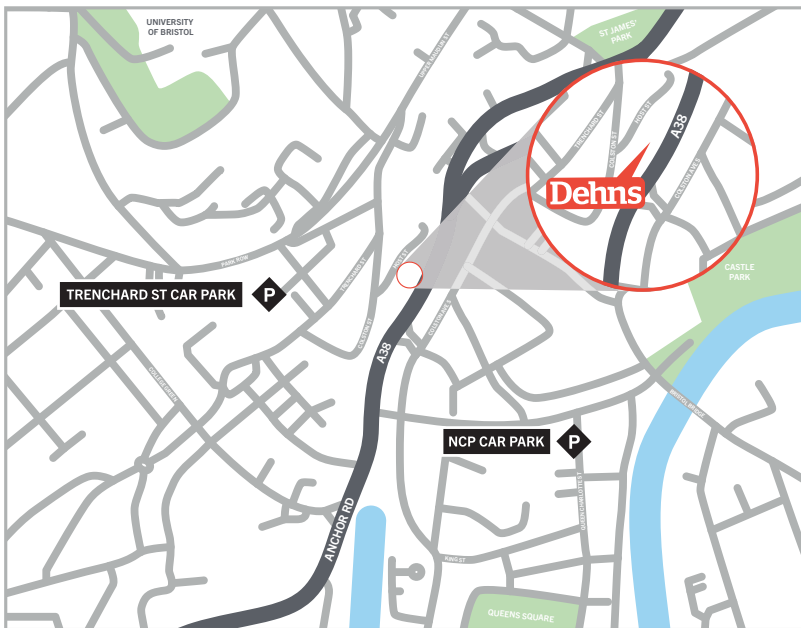

By train

33 Colston Avenue is a 15 to 20-minute walk from Bristol Temple Meads Station. From inside the station, follow signs to Temple Quay.

Turn left onto Friary and continue straight on across the roundabout to Victoria Street. Head along Victoria Street, cross Bristol Bridge onto High Street and then onto Broad Street. Turn left onto Quay Street and follow onto The Centre. 33 Colston Avenue is on the right hand side of The Centre facing the Cenotaph.

Please use the main entrance to the building to be greeted at Reception.

Numerous bus routes serve between Bristol Temple Meads Station and The Centre, including the 1, 2, 8 and 9.

By bike

There are bicycle parking facilities on site.

By car

33 Colston Avenue is easily accessible from the M4 and M5, and is just 4 minutes from the M32. Visitor parking is available on a first come basis. Public parking is also available at the following which are within easy walking distance:

- Trenchard Street Car Park
- Rupert Street Car Park
- The Galleries Car Park

By bus

33 Colston Avenue is about a 1 minute walk from The Centre bus stop served by numerous routes.

Please use the main entrance to the building opposite the bus stop to be greeted at Reception.
